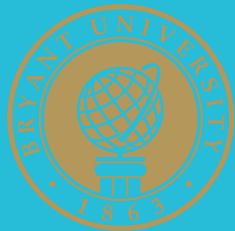

Financial Aid

Required form: Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Available at www.studentaid.gov
- FAFSA available October 1
- Preferred filing date: same as admission application

- Transfer students are eligible for both merit scholarships and need-based financial aid
- Merit Scholarships range from \$14,000-20,000 and are renewable
- PTK members are eligible for an additional \$2,500 scholarship

What You'll Need to Apply

Transfer candidates are expected to have maintained a satisfactory record and be in good academic standing.

You can apply online or download a PDF of our Bryant Transfer Application at www.bryant.edu/transfer. Applications may also be submitted through The Common Application at www.commonapp.org

We also require:

- A one-time, non-refundable \$50 fee (if you previously applied to Bryant, no fee is required)
- An official high school transcript
- An official college transcript from each college attended
- Standardized test scores if transferring with fewer than 30 credits at time of application (or you can apply test optional)
- A list of courses and course numbers not included on the college transcript that you expect to complete before the proposed date of transfer

Additional information that may be requested:

Mid-semester grade report, Certificate of Finances and supporting bank documents (International), University Transfer of VISA form (for international students who will transfer from an institution in the United States), Evidence of English language proficiency, such as TOEFL, IELTS scores (International)

TRANSFER CREDIT

- Up to 62 credits from a two-year college and 92 credits from a four-year college may be accepted for transfer credit at Bryant
- Courses in which a student has received a grade of "C" or better are transferrable, as long as the courses fit into the Bryant curriculum
- Certain courses may require the submission of a course syllabus and faculty approval for final course placement
